



Advance Care Planning

Online Course



Advance care planning promotes patient-centred care that focuses on respecting the patient's perspective on what matters the most to them. It also supports patients' rights to either consent to or refuse treatments. End of life conversations can be complex and emotional. This course is designed to provide health care professionals tools and best practices in advance care planning. Using case studies, participants will:

1. Learn how to help patients appoint a Power of Attorney and/or Substitute Decision Maker.
2. Identify communication techniques that will help patients articulate their values and beliefs about quality of life and dying.
3. Understand health care consent in relation to advance care planning.
4. Learn how to discuss critical care and life-sustaining treatments with patients in palliative care.
